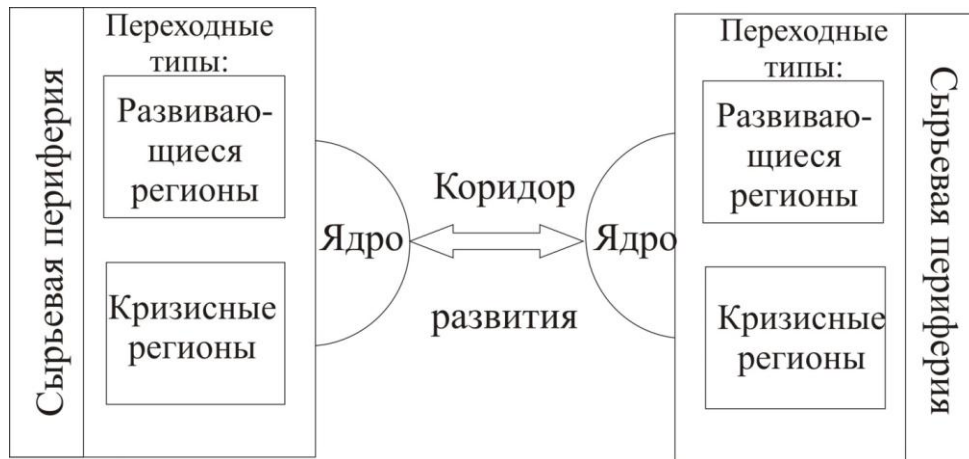


Fig. 1. Types of regions (according to J. Friedmann)

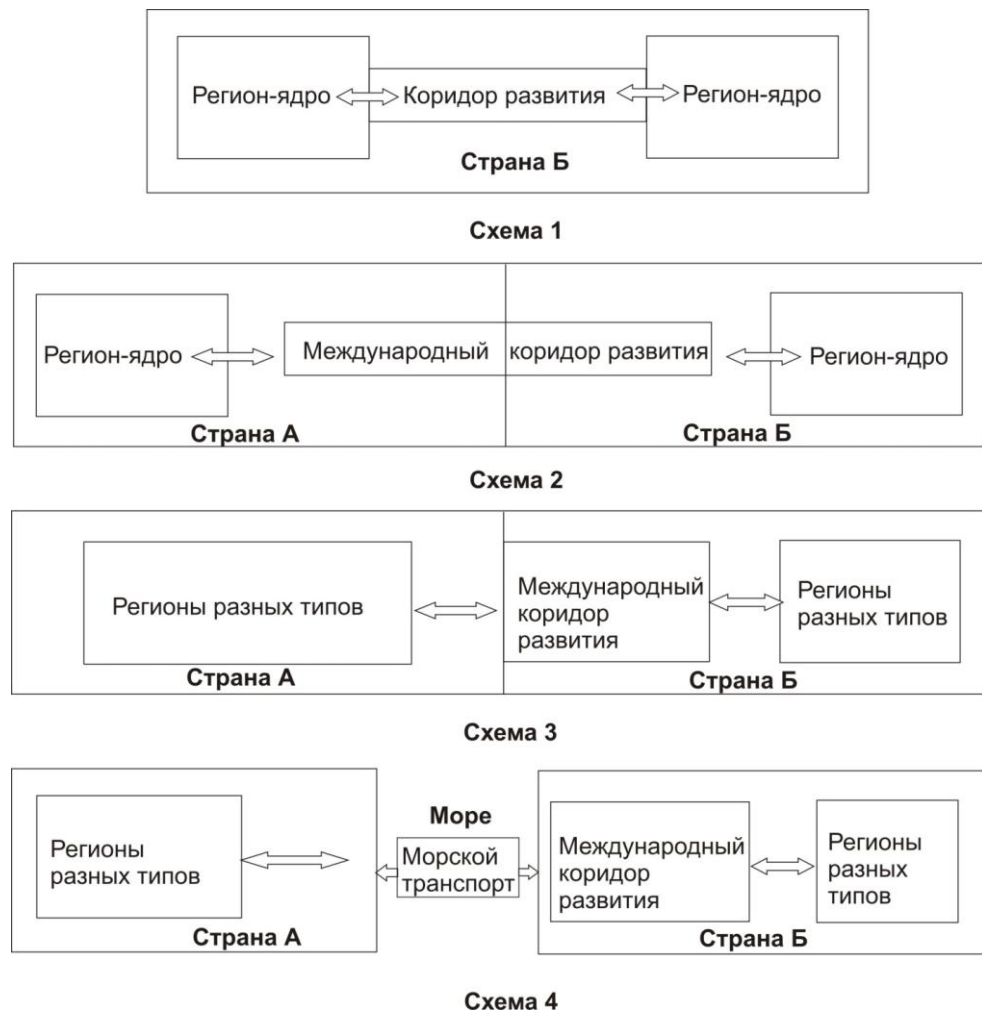


Fig. 2. Types of regions - development corridors:

- 4 - International seaside development corridor (on one side of the border)

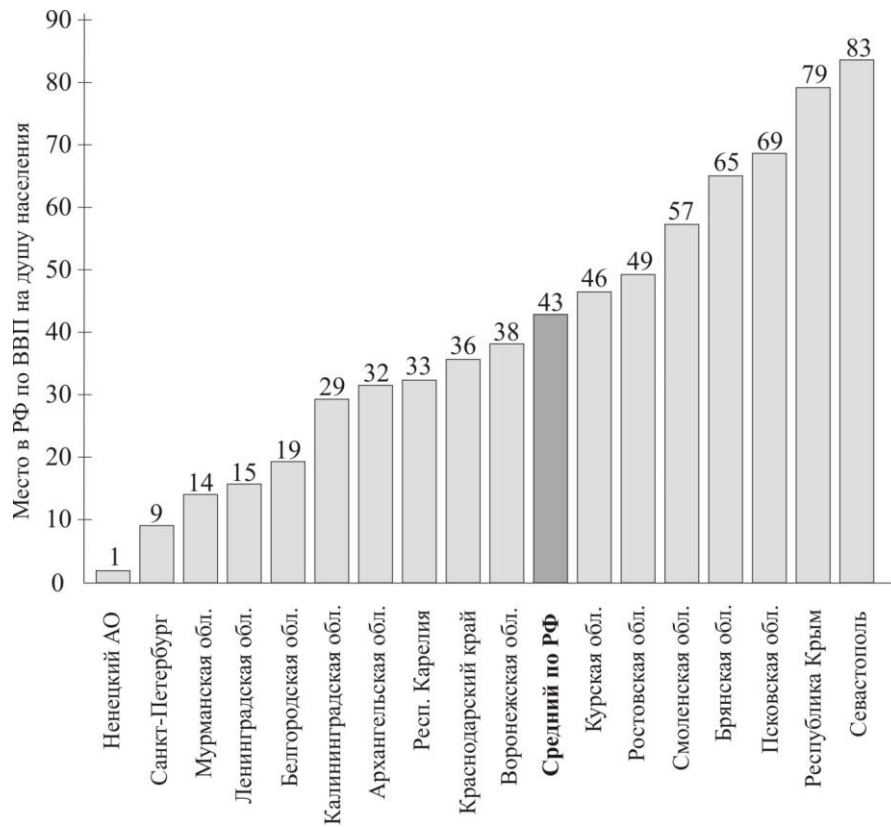


Fig. 3. Distribution of subjects of the Western cutting of Russia by the level of per capita GRP, 2016. Note: Compiled on the basis of information from the central statistical database of the Federal State Statistics Service.
